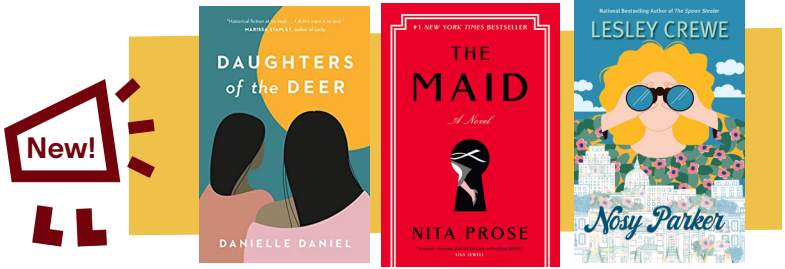

## How Can I Borrow a Book Club in a Bag?

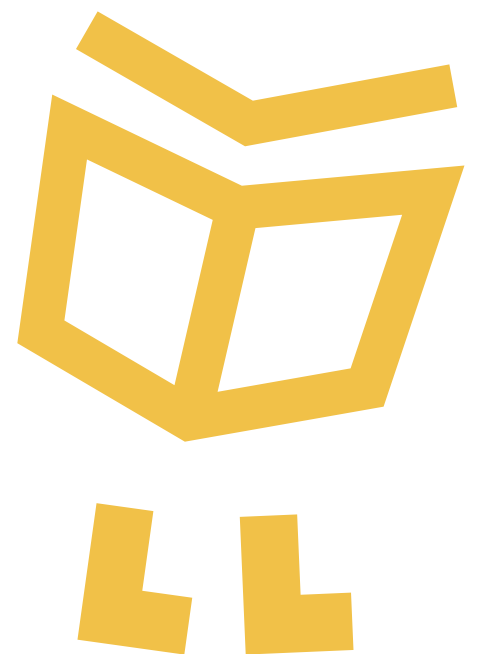
